1. Where do I submit my nomination?

Nomination shall include the signatures of five (5) OPIRG-Ottawa members in *good standing** as well as the signature of the person being nominated. Nomination should be sent by email to gripocampus@gmail.com. **The deadline to submit your nomination is Friday, February 26th, 2021 at 5 p.m.**

3. What should I write in my platform statement and how long should it be?

The platform statement is recommended to include:

- Who you are
- What interests you in getting involved with OPIRG
- Any relevant experience to OPIRG and its causes
- Any skills you wish to improve with OPIRG
- Any portfolios that may interest you (can be found in the constitution at opirg-gripo.ca)

The recommended length for platform statements is 250-500 words or more if desired.
